6 **WHEREAS**, the County of Will has the authority within a municipality to
7 exercise authority pursuant to the Illinois County Historic Preservation Law (55
8 ILC 5/5-30001 et seq.) to identify, protect, preserve and provide for the
9 restoration, rehabilitation and continued use of buildings, structures and sites
10 that are of historic significance if the municipality authorizes by ordinance the
11 County Board and the County Preservation Commission to designate such a
12 landmark within its corporate boundary (55 ILCS 5/5-30004 {17}); and

13 **WHEREAS**, the Village of Monee has received a request from the Monee
14 Historical Society, the nominator(s) of certain property located at 5162 W.
15 Court Street, Monee, IL 60449 for designation as a landmark for historical
16 preservation status; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the Village of Monee finds it in the best interest of its citizens to
18 accommodate the request of the Monee Historical Society and to authorize the
19 County of Will and the Will County Historic Preservation Commission to review
20 and consider 5162 W. Court Street, Monee, IL 60449 for historical
21 preservation status; and

22 **WHEREAS**, the elected officials are cognizant of the importance of preserving
23 landmarks which enhance the character of the Village of Monee.

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Board of Trustees
25 of the Village of Monee, a Home Rule Unit of Government, Will County, Illinois,
26 pursuant to its home rule powers, as follows:

27 **Section One—Preambles.** That the preambles above set forth are
28 incorporated herein as if set forth in full.

29 **Section Two—Recognition.** That the Village of Monee recognizes and
30 designates the property commonly known as 5162 W. Court Street, also
31 referred to as "The Creamery", as being historically significant.

32 **Section Three—Authorization.** That the Village of Monee hereby authorizes
33 and requests that the County of Will and the Will County Historic Preservation
34 Commission to review and consider 5162 W. Court Street, also known as "The
35 Creamery", for designation as a landmark for historic preservation per the
36 terms and provisions of the Illinois Historic Preservation Law.

37 **Section Four—Repealer.** That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in
38 conflict herewith are expressly repealed.

39 **Section Five—Savings Clause.** That in the event any portion of this
40 Ordinance is declared to be void, that such other parts or remainder of this
41 Ordinance shall not be adversely effected and shall otherwise remain effective
42 and valid.


43 **Section Six—Adoption Clause.** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and
