D. **Discussion of Police Activity in the Past 90 days**

Monee Police Chief, Scott Koerner started off by thanking Mayor Popp, Trustee Raczek and the other Trustees along with the rest of the board on their help with the community. He then spoke about the recent police activity stating that Domestic crimes were down 75%, Calls of service were up 500 calls, 3 burglaries to businesses all by interstate, about 700 business checks were done nightly and they are using aggressive police tactics. Chief Koerner also mentioned that 11 other communities had same crimes along with many communities all around and MPD has been cooperating with other agencies, Chicago, Crete, Peotone, Beecher and more. Chief requests that Monee residents PLEASE CONTACT POLICE 1st to show video surveillance and pictures of suspected burglars/robbers BEFORE posting to social media because many didn't even contact the police and on social media was the 1st time police had even seen footage. Chief Stated that increase will come to the police force as the community continues to grow. Trustee Gray (Chair Pro Temp) thanked the Monee police, Chief and reminded all, please pick up the phone and call MPD to report suspicious activity. Trustee Holston questioned if there were any talk about getting a k-9 dog for the MPD. Chief Koerner stated that in order to do so, they'd have to pull someone from patrol, have the dog trained, have the police trained and at this point believes that it's more of a luxury than a necessity.


E. **Discussion of Capital Improvement Projects**

Administrator Wallace went over a list of Capital Improvement Projects and they were discussed. It was mentioned that here is no actual list of priority. One project that stood out when mentioned was a new Water Tower. A Monee resident, excited to hear about it questioned where it would be located and how soon will it be done. Public Works Superintendent Kruzal stated that it will be located in the Southeast corner of our municipal area, close to Will Center road near County Fair. He also stated that it takes a year to build the 500,000 gallon water tower.
