The concrete work has been completed and the contractor (Iroquois Paving) will begin working on improving the asphalt pavement.

Starting next week, Iroquois Paving will remove all the asphalt within the referenced roadways down to the aggregate base. The contractor will regrade the aggregate base and will then place two (2) layers of asphalt.

Weather permitting, on October 27th, Iroquois Paving will remove the asphalt along Linden Avenue and McCorkle Avenue down to the aggregate base. The next day, October 28th, they are planning on placing the first layer of asphalt along these same roads. Parking will be restricted on these roadways during working hours of 6:30 am to 6:30 pm on both October 27th and October 28th. **Parking will be allowed within driveway areas. However, please note that there will be a ±4" step at the front of the curb once the asphalt is removed.** Residents with vehicles that have low ground clearance are recommended to park their vehicles along Middlepoint Avenue and Coleman Place (excluding the cul de sac to the east at the intersection of Coleman Place and McCorkle Avenue) during this time.

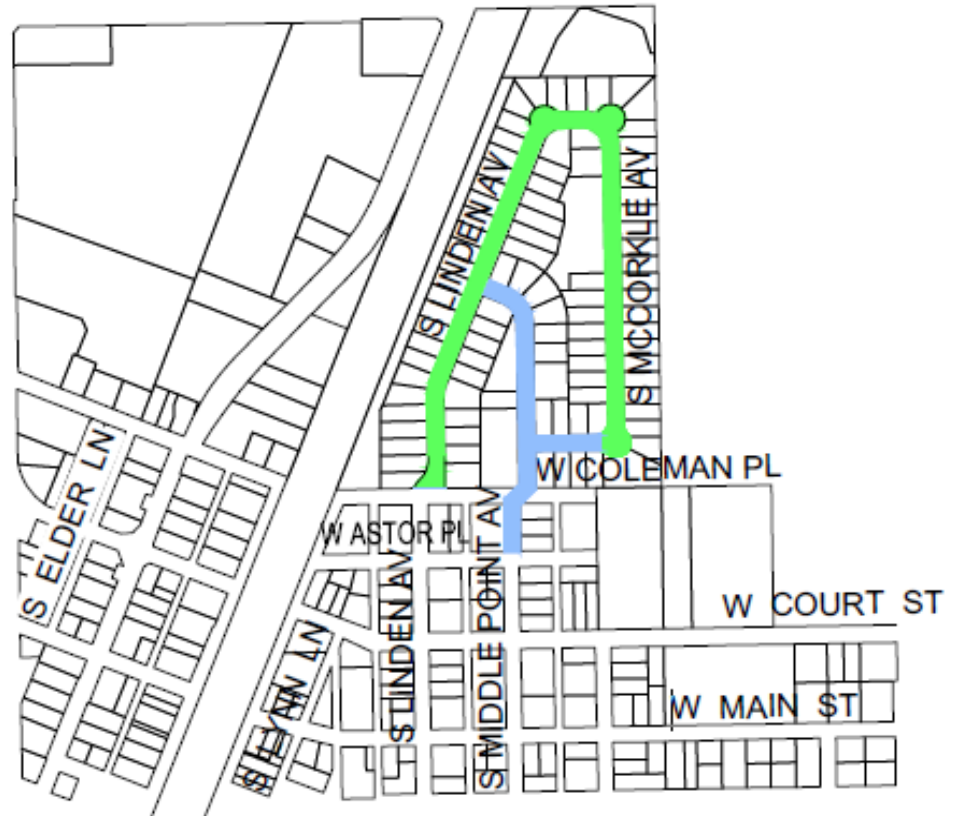

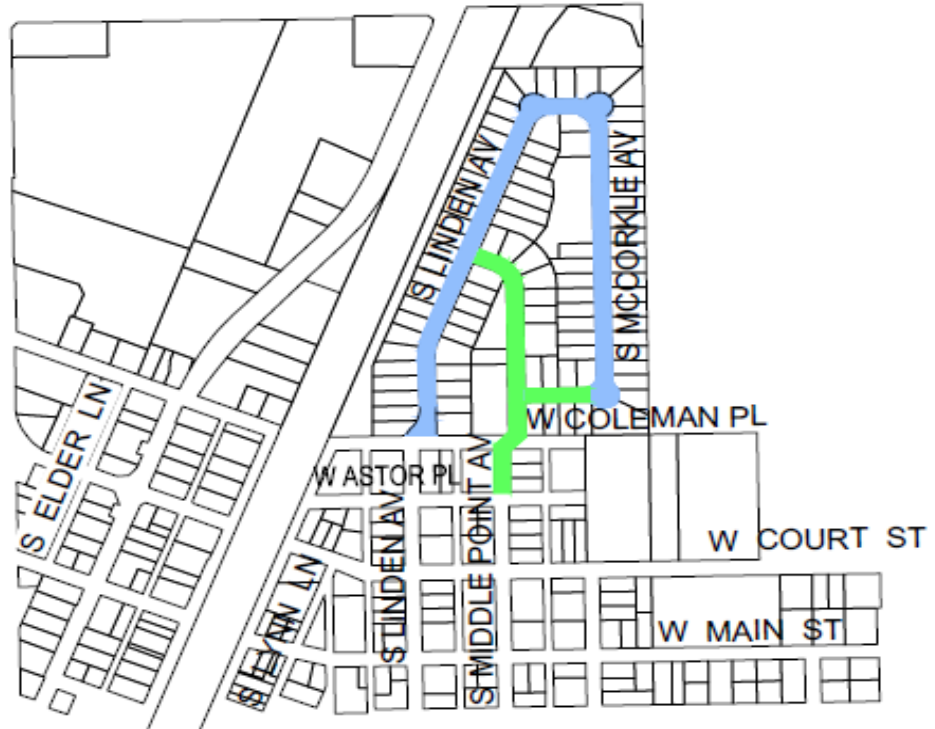




-  AREA OF ROAD WORK: NO PARKING ON ROADWAYS

October 27th and October 28th Roadway Parking Information

October 29th and October 30th

Weather permitting, on October 29th, Iroquois Paving will remove the asphalt along Middlepoint Avenue and Coleman Place down to the aggregate base. The next day, October 30th, they are planning on placing the first layer of asphalt along these same roads. Parking will be restricted on these roadways during working hours of 6:30 am to 6:30 pm on both October 29th and October 30th. **Parking will be allowed within driveway areas. However, please note that there will be a ±4" step at the front of the curb once the asphalt is removed.** Residents with vehicles that have low ground clearance are recommended to park their vehicles along Linden Avenue and McCorkle Avenue during this time.

October 29th and October 30th Roadway Parking Information

Week of November 1st

The second (final) layer of asphalt is anticipated to be placed along all the roadways the week of November 1st. Parking will be restricted along all roadways this week during working hours of 6:30 am to 6:30 pm until this second layer of asphalt is placed on your street. It is anticipated that residents will be able to access their driveways this week.

Please note that daytime and overnight parking will be available at both the Village Hall (5130 W. Court Street) and Firemen's Park (5218 W. Court Street) while all work is being performed within the McCorkle Subdivision area.

The contractor will post "No Parking" signs each day accordingly along each roadway where parking will be restricted.
